Clyde and Loch Lomond Cycleway

This 20 mile cycleway and footpath forms part of the Lochs and Glens National Cycle Route. It takes you from the heart of Glasgow to the beauty of Loch Lomond. Starting at Bell's Bridge, it passes Clydebank and runs along the Forth and Clyde canal to Bowling, before turning at Dumbarton to follow the meandering River Leven up to Balloch and the Loch Lomond and The Trossachs National Park.

As the route runs close to the railway, you can hop on a train with your bike at almost any point. The route is traffic-free, except for a short section through Dumbarton.

Sustrans - the sustainable transport charity - works on practical projects to encourage people to walk, cycle and use public transport in order to reduce motor traffic and its adverse effects.
