

Update Slip for map NN1E – Aberdeen to John O’Groats

The following sections of route have changed since the map was published. Please visit our website at www.sustrans.org.uk and enter the relevant town name in the search box on the right of the homepage, to see a map of the current route. If you do not have internet access the call the Sustrans Information Service on 0845 113 0065 for further details.

Panel 1 – Miles 3 – 9: There is now a cycle path for some of the route through Dyce from Stoneywood with a different arrangement to the Dyce route detail shown.

Panel 2 – Mile 40: The campground is actually to the north of the route, between Mile 40 and New Blyth.

Panel 2/3 – Miles 48 – 51: The route through Turriff now follows the orange dotted route through the town centre.

Panel 3 – Miles 58 - 63: The signed route now follows the route marked for “Alternative Route for laden tourers”. There is still the option of two routes between Miles 64 and 66.

Panel 3/4 - Miles 77 – 93: Major changes to route between Cullen and Garmouth. Please refer to the “Cullen to Garmouth” leaflet. This can be downloaded here:

Panel 6 – Miles 131 – 140: There is now an alternative route signed via Cawdor.

Panel 10 – National Route 1 is now signed from Ulsta to Norwick (on Unst beyond the shown map). PTO

IMPORTANT: Ferries from Aberdeen to Orkney and between Orkney and Shetland (Lerwick) now operate out of KIRKWALL not Stromness. (The ferry from Scrabster still operates to Stromness)
