

Update Slip for map NN4B – Celtic Trail (East)

The following section of route has changed since the map was published. The ‘Get Cycling’ section of www.sustrans.org.uk includes online mapping featuring the latest route detail. If you require any further assistance, please call the Sustrans Information Service on tel: 0845 113 00 65.

Panel 1:

Proposed bridge over Ebbw River built. Both shown route alongside A48 and orange dotted route now signed and open between mile markers 23 and 25.

Proposed route NOT open between mile markers 25 and 27.

At Draethen (mile marker 31) the route now follows the proposed dotted orange route to Machen.

Panel 2a / 2b:

Proposed route NOT open along south coast to Barry.

New section of NCN 8 route completed along the Taff Trail at Taffs Well. Both the shown route skirting Ty Rhiw and the orange dotted route can be used.

Proposed route from Caerphilly to Dreathen on NCN route 4 is now open and signed between mile markers 38 and 31 through Machen (see panel 1 for detail covered by text box)

Proposed route from Glyncoch to Ynysybwl now open, but not link from Ynysybwl to NCN 47 on the High Level Route.

Proposed link to Penderyn NOT open.

Panel 3:

Changes to routes around Newport as per Panel 1.

Small proposed section of NCN route 46 open through Forge Side as per orange dots.

Panel 4:

Small proposed section of NCN route 46 open through Forge Side as per orange dots. (as per panel 3)

Other proposed sections still awaiting development.

Panel 5:

Proposed route NOT open between mile markers 52 and 56.

Proposed link to Byrncethin NOT open.

Link route to Bridgend now open, follow orange dots through Sarn.

Link route to Blaengarw now open, follow orange dots close by A4064.

Proposed route on NCN route 4 NOT open between mile markers 65 and 67.

Proposed route on NCN route 47 around Cefnmawr Mountain NOT open.

Proposed route between Clyne and Morfa Glas in the Vale of Neath open.
