

## Update Slip for map NN1A - Hull to Fakenham Cycle Route

---

The following sections of route have changed since the map was published.

**Panel 1b** The link route to Grimsby is not yet signed. When it is it will be signed as National Route 69.

**Panel 3 / 4** The telephone number for Lincoln Tourist Information is now: 01522 873213

**Panel 4** The proposed traffic-free route from Washingborough to Kirkstead is now open, but does not currently provide a continuous route from Lincoln city centre to Martin Dales using National Route 1. You can join the traffic free section in Lincoln by following Rumbold St, Croft Street, Baggholme Road, Stamp End and then cross the river Witham on to Waterside South. Alternatively you can follow National Route 1 through to Fiskerton and join the traffic-free path there. The route is now continuous to Kirkstead (Mile 78). The route is not yet fully signed as National Route 1. Please note the completed route passes to the east of the sugar factory in Bardney, not between the river and the factory.

**Panel 5** The proposed riverside path from Anton's Gowt to Boston is now open and signed as National Route 1. At Boston aim for the high church tower of Boston Stump (St. Botolph's), the loop around the north-east side of the church into Market Square. The one way system is not good for cyclists, especially if you are going south when it is best to use the footway of the Haven Bridge. (Search on 'Anton's Gowt'). Anton's Gowt to Langrick Bridge is still proposed and the road route via Langrick must be used.

**Panel 5 / 6** There is now a traffic-free route on the Fosdyke Bridge between Miles 104 and 105.

**Panel 6** There has been changes to the route from Wisbech towards West Walton. The mapped route can still be followed, but National Route 1 is now signed via Wisbech Park and Tavistock Road. Search "Wisbech" on our online mapping.

**Panel 7** Between Miles 146 and 151 (Wiggenhall St. Germans to King's Lynn) a new route goes via Abbey Farm, then towards Saddle Bow and via the power station to follow the riverside path along the east side of the Ouse into Kings Lynn (joining with the marked riverside path).

**Panel 7** Between Miles 154 and 161 north of King's Lynn there have been route improvements through North Wootton and a new traffic-free path alongside the A149. Search "Castle Rising" on our online mapping. The route has not changed through the Sandringham Estate.

**Panel 8** Between Miles 188 and 191 an attractive route now goes through Holkham Park to Wells-next-the-Sea. You can download a PDF for the route from [www.sustrans.org.uk/webfiles/leaflets/WellsandHolkham.pdf](http://www.sustrans.org.uk/webfiles/leaflets/WellsandHolkham.pdf) (or search on Holkham Hall on our online mapping).

**Panel 8** Mile 195. At Little Walsingham you can join the railway path (search on Little Walsingham).

**Panel 8** There is no longer a Tourist Information Centre in Fakenham, a 24 hour tourist information kiosk is available at Fakenham Connect, Oak Street, Fakenham.
