

Update Slip for map NN1B - Fakenham to Harwich Cycle Route

The following sections of route and information have changed since the map was published.

Panel 1 National Route 13 now joins National Route 1 at Manor House (near Mile 242).

Panel 1 Between Miles 230 and 237 (Reepham and Foulsham) the signed route is now via Guestwick Green (marked on map with orange dots).

Panel 1 There is no longer a Tourist Information Centre in Fakenham, a 24 hour tourist information kiosk is available at Fakenham Connect, Oak Street, Fakenham.

Panel 2 Two Rivers Cycle Route - Regional Route 30 is signed from Ellingham to Bungay on a traffic free route parallel to the A143 (on the south side), and from Beccles to Lowestoft.

Panel 4a / 4b Aldeburgh Tourist Information Centre is now at 152 High Street, Aldeburgh, Suffolk, IP15 5AQ.

Panel 4b Between Miles 145 and 151 National Route 1 is now signed via Chillesford to avoid the ferry crossing.

Panel 4b The route from Felixstowe to Landguard Fort has been improved by a new traffic-free section.

Panel 5 There have been improvements to the cycle network in Colchester (search on 'Colchester') A free Colchester cycling map is available from Essex County Council on 01245 437092.

Panel 6 Telephone number for the Harwich, Felixstowe, and Shotley ferry is now: 07919911440

Panel 6 The route between Colchester, Wivenhoe and Harwich is now signed as National Route 51.

Panel 6 A new traffic-free section of route in Harwich at Dovercourt has improved the approach to the port (search on 'Harwich').
