

Update Slip for map NN3AA – The West Country Way Cycle Route

The following sections of route have changed since the map was published.

The ‘Get Cycling’ section of www.sustrans.org.uk includes online mapping featuring the latest route detail.

Changes are listed in the direction of Padstow to Bristol.

Panel 2 – If using the alternative route between **Miles 34 and 50** (Hallworthy and Marhamchurch) there is a short cut via Titson Farm.

Panel 5 – There is no camping in Dulverton (there is a Caravan Club site for caravans only). There is Northcombe Camping Barn just outside the town. Check www.yha.org.uk for details.

Panel 6 – There has been route alignment changes through Taunton between Miles 167 and 169. Please search “Taunton” and select “Taunton, Taunton Dean” on our online mapping.

Panel 7 – The proposed route between **Miles 186 and 189** (Chedzoy and Bawdrip) is now open and provides a traffic free route alongside the King’s Sedgemoor Drain. Please note the route is now on the Chedzoy side of the river. Search “Chedzoy” on our online mapping.

Panel 7 – Between **Miles 189 and 190** there is a slight change to the route so that the railway path now starts / finishes just to the east of Bawdrip. Search “Bawdrip” on our online mapping..

Panel 7 – The proposed route between **Miles 213 and 214** (Wells and Wookey Hole) is now open. Search “Haybridge” and select “Haybridge, Mendip” on our online mapping for route details.

Panel 7 – Between **Miles 223 and 226** the route no longer passes through West Harptree. The route takes the direct minor road between the pub symbol close to Harptree Farm and the pub symbol at Mile 226 and White Cross Farm.

Panel 8 – Between **Miles 227 and 228** the route is now straight and parallel to the B3114.

Panel 8 – The Avon Cycleway is also signed as Regional Route 10. A detailed route map of the Avon Valley Cycleway is available for free from Bristol City Council.
