

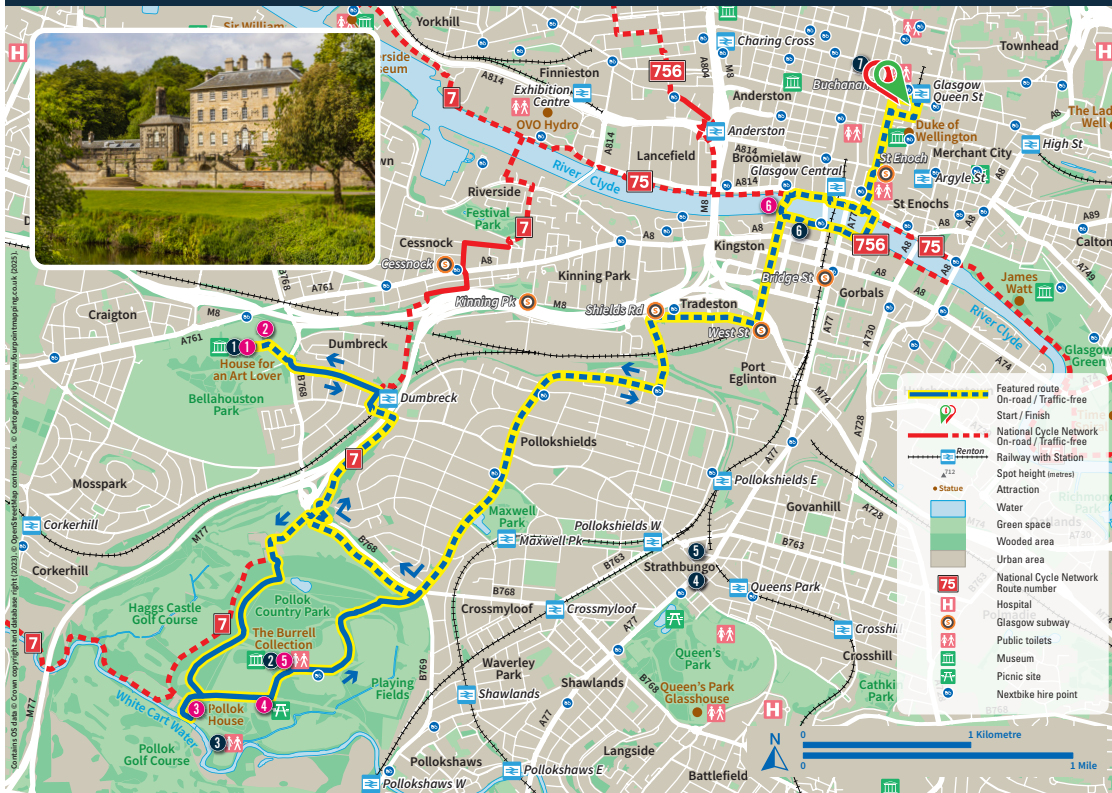

ROUTE DESCRIPTION

Head south from George Square and cross the River Clyde via the South Portland Street Suspension Bridge. Head West along the river bank to connect with the South West City Way Cycle Path, and follow this south and west, to the edge of Pollok Country Park, from here Bellahouston Park – and the highly acclaimed House for an Art Lover – is just a short ride away.

Now retrace your route and enter Pollok Country Park. At over 140 hectares, this award-winning park is Glasgow's largest green space and home to historic Pollok House with its beautiful walled gardens and 19th century stabling and sawmill. It is also home to a much loved herd of over 50 Highland cows, who have been a feature of the park for over 180 years!

The world renowned Burrell Collection is housed within the park, offers free entry, and showcases priceless paintings, sculptures, tapestries and medieval weaponry.
