Sustainable school runs

Walking bus established either daily, weekly or monthly

Park and stride established for those needing to drive further than 2 miles

Consider School Streets (contact us for more information)

Promotion of 'considerate' parking

Parking restrictions and informing parents about what different parking restrictions really mean

Run and Park Safe, Walk Safe Campaign or use elements from it to tackle issues with regards to parking at your school







Promoting walking, wheeling, and cycling

PTA actively involved in active travel events such as walking bus, special events

Take part in 'Walk to School Week'

Walk once a Week (WoW) by Living Streets

Provide a shelter for parents/carers/pupils, so they can shelter if it is raining

Provide storage for buggies - if you have nursery classes

Set up a pedometer challenge

Provide balance bike training for younger pupils

Introduce/increase the number of children attending Bikeability cycle training

Organise family bike maintenance training (Dr.Bike)

Provide transition training for year 6 pupils, so they are prepared for the journey to secondary school

Cycle training and maintenance for staff

Publicise the Tax-Free Bike Scheme to staff (cycle to work schemes)

Increase cycle storage / changing facilities for pupils and staff

Active travel school facilities

Support accessing funding for scooter/bike storage

Accessible changing facilities for pupils and Staff who travel actively

Road Safety

Sign up to road safety events

Incorporate road safety education into the curriculum

Liaise with the Road Safety Team in Local Authority to see what is available in terms of theatre in education and resources

Have a road safety themed assembly once a term / annually

Improve paths for pedestrians and/or cyclists/wheelers within the school grounds







General

A safe place on schools' grounds to store bikes and scooters

School to participate in one active travel event per year

Staff training or session on active travel

Posters inside and around school promoting active travel

All staff to make a yearly commitment to trying to travel actively at least once a week

After school club on active travel

Participation in partner programme: Welsh Cycling, Living Streets

Liaise with neighbouring schools to tackle problems jointly

Encourage visitors to travel actively

Zero Emissions Day

World Car-free Day Encourage families to leave the car at home for a day including incentives for pupils who do not arrive by car.

Bike to School Week

World Heart Day Activities during the day to get pupils aware of their heart's health and how active travel can help keep hearts healthy

Walk to school month Walk to school week, Walking bus to school, Jazz up your Jacket competition or activity, Design clothing/ footwear for the perfect walk to school

International Walk to school day Walking Bus to school/ Walking incentive for families/pupils

World Mental Health Day

Encourage your pupils, parents and staff to come to school actively for the day to raise awareness of the benefits of active travel to mental health and boost their well-being

Clocks go back (Solstice) Encourage use of lights, reflectors and bright clothing for fun and to keep safe! Try a competition for brightest dressed, organise Gear Sales







Halloween

Bling your bike/Spruce up your scooter/Jazz up your jacket to theme before half term

Diwali

Hindu festival of light Encourage use of lights, reflectors and bright clothing. Assembly – Be Bright! Competition for brightest dressed

World Children's Day

Get the pupils involved in organising a day of active travel activities

Road Safety Week

International Disability Awareness Day

Discuss what disabilities people may face and what types of wheeled equipment might be suitable

Christmas fair

Information for parents on types of bikes and scooters to buy

Spring Term

New Year's resolutions To walk, scoot, cycle to school (and elsewhere) more often

Chinese New Year

Chinese themed bling your bike/scooter/jacket

Investigate how pupils travel to school in China

St Dwynwen's Day

Love your walk/cycle/scoot to school?
