Where are we now?

Currently our school is struggling to manage safe parking and school congestion. We are located alongside a busy 'B road' without safe pavements, crossings and safe space for parents to park.

Parents are parking on double yellow lines outside school and causing disruption for through traffic. Due to the lack of safe infrastructure, very small numbers of parents and pupils travel actively.

What do we want to change?

We would like to encourage people throughout the village to travel actively. (Many students live under 1 mile from the school). Also, we would like to set up a park and stride option for parents and children who live in surrounding rural areas. We will need safe infrastructure and cycle confidence sessions to achieve this.

Goals for academic year

1: Set up a Park and Stride for parents and learners in surrounding rural areas.

2: Infrastructure: Bike Storage and a safe pedestrian crossing

3: Restart Bikeability and find support teaching pupils to cycle safely.

Other notes:

We are currently taking part in Eco Schools and creating an Active Travel School Plan will hopefully inspire pupils to make impactful environmental action.

We have had support from Sustrans before Covid which was very beneficial to us. However, due to a change in staff over the last few years we have found it difficult to prioritise Active Travel.
