Celtic Trail / Lôn Geltaidd (4)

From Nantgarw to Machen, this wonderful section of the Celtic Trail will take you on a journey through the heart of Caerphilly and past the magnificent Caerphilly Castle. The Celtic Trail runs from Chepstow to Fishguard – offering endless 2-wheeled opportunities for the more experienced cyclist.

O Nantgarw i Fachen, bydd yr adran hyfryd hon o'r Lôn Geltaidd yn mynd â chi ar daith drwy ganol Caerffili a heibio'r Castell godidog. Mae'r Lôn Geltaidd yn ymestyn o Gas-gwent i Abergwaun – sy'n rhoi cyfleoedd diddiwedd ar ddwy olwyn ar gyfer y beicwyr mwy profiadol.

Taff Trail / Taith Taf (8)

The 55-mile trail links Caerphilly to Cardiff, Pontypridd, Merthyr Tydfil and northwards to the stunning Brecon Beacons. A great trail for novice and leisure cyclists, as well as an easy commuter link to and from Caerphilly.

Mae'r llwybr 55 milltir o hyd yn cysylltu Caerffili i Gaerdydd, Pontypridd, Merthyr Tudful a'r holl ffordd i fyny i Fannau Brycheiniog godidog. Llwybr gwych ar gyfer beicwyr newydd a beicwyr hamdden, yn ogystal â dolen gymudo hawdd i ac o Gaerffili.

Heads of the Valley / Blaenau'r Cymoedd (46)

This route is not short of a hill or two, but the views are well worth the effort. Perfect for the more experienced cyclist looking for an invigorating 2-wheel adventure. There are also some fabulous family friendly sections around Brynmawr and within Parc Bryn Bach.

Mae sawl rhiw ar y llwybr hwn, ond mae'r golygfeydd yn werth yr ymdrech. Perffaith ar gyfer y beicwyr fwy profiadol sy'n chwilio am antur egniol ar ddwy olwyn. Ceir hefyd rai adrannau gwych sy'n addas i'r teulu o amgylch Brynmawr ac o fewn Parc Bryn Bach.

Three Parcs Trail / Llwybr y Tri Pharc (47)

A brilliant route that passes through three country parks from Sirhowy Valley Country Park to Trelewis. There's plenty to see, including Hengoed's listed viaduct, the well known landmark 'The Wheel of Drums' and Sultan the Pit Pony, the UK's largest figurative earth sculpture, as well as spectacular views across the county borough from Parc Penallta. The route continues onto Newport along a traffic-free path.

Llwybr gwych sy'n mynd drwy dri pharc gwledig o Barc Gwledig Sirhywi i Drelewis. Mae digon i'w weld, yn cynnwys traphont restredig Hengoed, tirnod adnabyddus yr 'Olwyn Dramiau' a Swltan y Ferlen Pwll Glo, cerflun pridd ffigurol mwyaf y DU, yn ogystal â golygfeydd ysblennydd ar draws y fwrdeistref sirol o Barc Penallta. Mae'r llwybr yn parhau i Gasnewydd ar lwybr di-draffig.

Aber Valley / Cwm Aber (475)

Once leaving Caerphilly town this path follows the disused railway line and winds on to Abertridwr and Senghenydd where you'll find reminders of the human cost of the area's industrial history. It is worth riding or walking this route to fit in with opening hours at the Aber Valley Heritage Museum in Senghenydd Community Centre.

Wrth adael tref Caerffili mae'r llwybr hwn yn dilyn rheilffordd segur ac yn nadreddu ymlaen i Abertridwr a Senghenydd lle gallwch weld olion cost i ddynoliaeth ei fawredd diwydiannol. Mae'n werth beicio neu gerdded y llwybr hwn pan fydd Canolfan Dreftadaeth ac Amgueddfa Cwm Aber yng Nghanolfan Gymunedol Senghenydd ar agor.

Llanhilleth to Abertillery/Brynmawr / Llanhilledd i Abertylleri/ Brynmawr (465)

Travel along the Ebbw Fach Trail under the watchful gaze of Guardian, the memorial to the Six Bells mining disaster of 1960.

Teithiwch ar hyd Llwybr Ebwy Fach o dan lygad craff Cerflun 'Gwarcheidwad y Cymoedd' Six Bells sy'n coffau trychineb pwll glo drasig 1960.

Blackwood to Hollybush / Coed Duon i Lwyncelyn (467)

This route from Blackwood to Hollybush, via Argoed, starts near the iconic Chartist Bridge and runs alongside the river for a picturesque ride right in the middle of the County Borough.

Mae'r llwybr hwn o Goed Duon i Lwyncelyn, drwy Argoed, yn dechrau wrth dirnod eiconig Pont y Siartwyr ac yn mynd ar lan yr afon gan roi taith brydferth yng nghanol y Fwrdeistref Sirol.

Rhymney Valley / Cwm Rhymni (468) Darran Valley / Cwm Darran (469)

The Darran Valley cycle path runs along an abandoned rail track and under a number of historic bridges to take you to Fochriw. Travel through the tranquil Parc Cwm Darran and the wildflower meadows of Cwmlledrew Meadows Local Nature Reserve. The Rhymney Valley route travels through New Tredegar, past the fascinating Winding House Museum and onwards to Rhymney and the 'Twisted Chimney' artwork.

Mae llwybr beicio Cwm Darran yn rhedeg ar hyd llwybr rheilffordd wed'i adael, o dan nifer o bontydd hanesyddol i'ch cymryd at Fochriw. Teithiwch ar hyd Parc Cwm Darran tawel a dolydd blodau gwyllt Gwarchodfa Natur Leol Dolydd Cwmlledrew. Mae llwybr Cwm Rhymni yn teithio trwy Dredegar Newydd, gan basio Amgueddfa'r Ty Weindio hudol ac ymlaen tuag at Rymni a'r gwaith celf y 'Simnai Ddirdro.
