Reshaping the built environment to support active travel by:

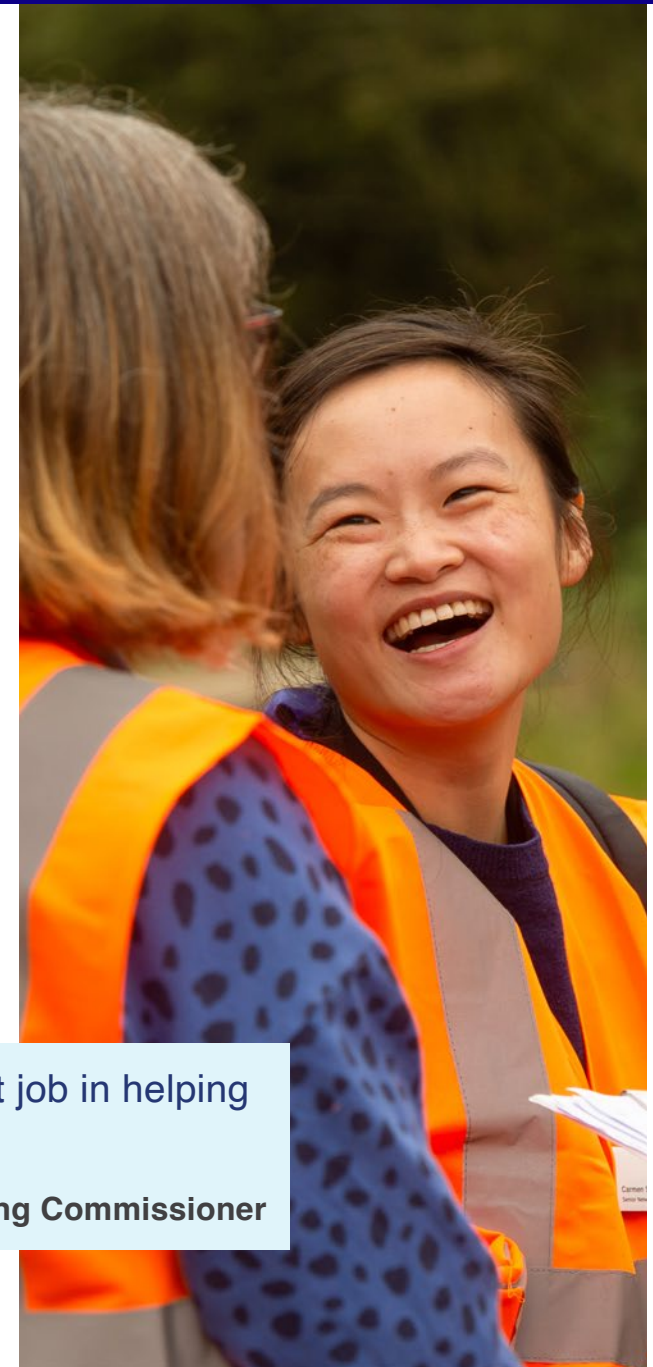
- » developing active travel network and infrastructure plans
