Free access to activity guides, curriculum resources, online travel challenges and the Active Travel School Award scheme. Schools can also access a range of incentives and discounts to support and promote active travel.

Opportunities for young people, teachers, parents and governors to develop the confidence, enthusiasm and skills to travel actively to school.

Healthier lifestyles



Being active on the journey to school helps improve general health and wellbeing of the school community along with other benefits such as improved concentration, performance, behaviour and attainment.

Improved air quality



Getting the school community active on the journey to school helps to reduce congestion and improve air quality around schools.

Partnerships



Giving schools support to engage with local authorities, councillors and other organisations so they can work together in making the most of any opportunities to improve active travel within the local community.

Active Travel School Award

The Active Travel School Award guides schools through the key steps for increasing and sustaining the number of pupils travelling to school actively.

It enables schools to track progress through three levels - bronze, silver and gold - in becoming beacons of best practice. Each level offers supporting resources and guidance for achieving success.

The award supports schools with collecting evidence towards Transport, Health and Wellbeing sections of Eco Schools and Healthy Schools Awards.





Active travel mapping workshops

A bespoke range of interactive mapping workshops designed to get the school community thinking about active travel on the journey to school and within the local community.

Feedback from these workshops can be shared with local authority partners to help develop active travel routes to school.



Curriculum resources
